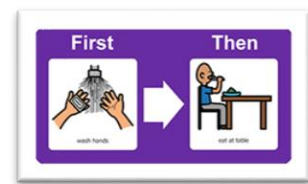


Hadfield Infant School



SEND Support Information Leaflet



Hadfield Infant School is a mainstream primary school which caters for children aged from 4 to 7 years old. Our school is fully inclusive for all children and has provision to support a wide range of disabilities including wheelchair access, sensory awareness, calm zones and visual timetables within classrooms. Our school also has a fully equipped disabled toilet with changing facilities.

How will our school support your child with SEND?

- We will liaise regularly with you as parents/carers
- We will create a One Page Profile for your child to outline your child's needs and create individual targets which will be shared with you.
- We will support your child's learning and maximize their opportunities using a range of strategies including extra support in class, catch up programmes, intervention programmes, carefully monitored target plans and ensuring that your child's learning is both accessible and fun.
- We will work closely with any outside agencies involved with your child, such as Speech and Language Therapy, Physiotherapy, Educational Psychology and make any new referrals if necessary after discussion with you.
- We will support you and your child through any new funding or application processes including referrals or EHCP applications.
- We will hold monthly SENDCO drop ins.
- We will provide a carefully supported transition process as your child joins our school community and throughout their school pathway at Hadfield Infant School.
