## 1. Rationale

At Hadfield Infant School we want our children to be proud to belong to a safe and happy environment in which to learn. We believe that encouraging the wearing of a school uniform can help to foster this sense of belonging and nurture cohesion, helping to promote good relationships between pupils.

## 2. Aims

- All children to come to school in clothing that is safe and appropriate for their age and the activities they will be undertaking.
- All children to wear school colours to foster a sense of shared belonging.
- The Governing body at Hadfield Infant School will respect variations to our school uniform if they are directly related to established religious or cultural traditions. However, any variation will be dealt with on an individual basis and judgements will remain at the discretion of the Headteacher and Governing Body.

## 3. Guidelines

- Pupils are asked to wear (as a minimum) a blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan over a yellow polo shirt, a grey/black pinafore dress or grey/black skirt or grey/black trousers.
- In warmer weather a simple blue checked dress, a yellow polo shirt, and grey/black school shorts are also acceptable.
- Parents must provide their child with a P.E kit consisting of shorts, tee-shirt and plimsolls kept in a draw string bag. P.E tee-shirts and bags with the school logo are again available, but are not compulsory.
- Footwear should be sensible and appropriate and black in colour. Heels are not permitted.
- All items of uniform should be clearly marked with the child's name and class.

Uniform with the school logo on is available to order from Brigadoon in Hadfield or Bulldog Fashion in Glossop. Additional items of uniform with the school logo are also available if desired including a fleece, reversible coat, school bag and hat. Whilst it is desirable that children have items of uniform with the school logo, this is not compulsory. Parents may buy uniform from wherever they wish, but we do ask that it matches the school colours.

There is a lost property box in each classroom, where all items of unnamed, mislaid uniform will be placed.
