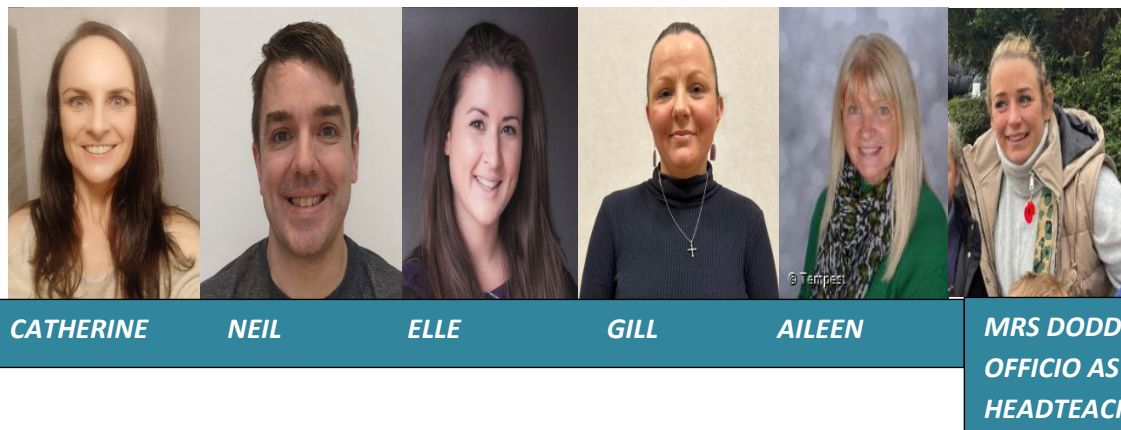


## **SUMMER TERM 2026-GOVERNORS NEWSLETTER**

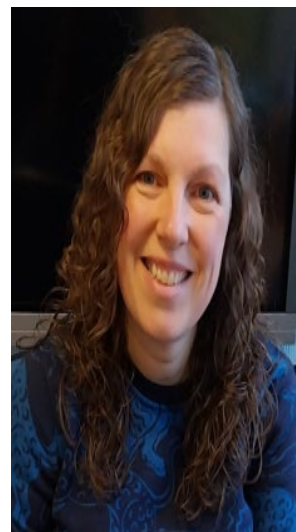
The other committee our Teaching and Learning and Community Links is chaired by Cilla Hollman has been concentrating on individual governors meeting up with their link subject coordinators .

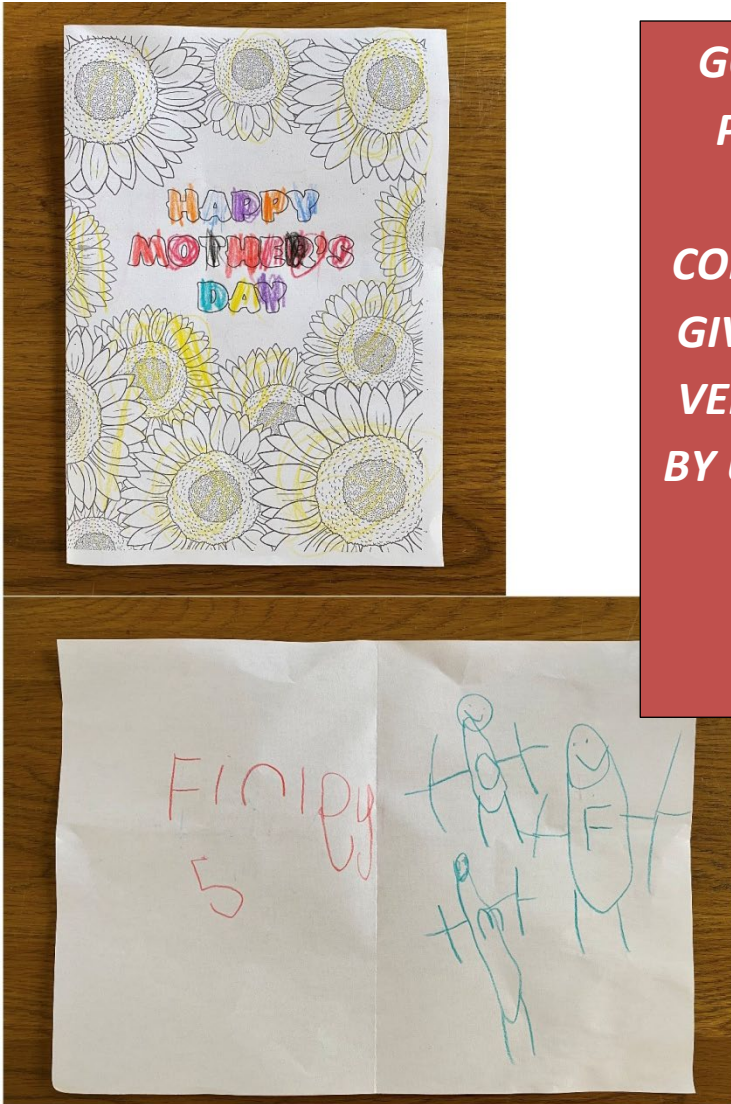
**A MOTHERS DAY TO REMEMBER SHARED BY ONE OF OUR PARENT GOVERNOR**
